



# During a drought, there's less water for all of these things:








We can't make it rain, but we can do a lot to help during a drought!



## During a drought, forest fires can start very quickly. Let's help the forest! We can do that by not lighting a campfire.










### Irrigation brings water to dry soil and crops. Connect the dots to bring water to these thirsty plants!

### For Parents & Guardians

Here are some simple questions and answers to help you talk to your child about drought.

What is it called when it hasn't rained in a long time? Answer: A drought.

#### What are the signs of drought?

Answer: The soil is dry and cracked and some plants turn brown.

#### What is Mulch?

Answer: A material spread over the ground to provide a protective layer that retains water.

### What is irrigation?


Answer: Irrigation is when farmers bring water to their crops. Many farmers in the Coachella Valley use Colorado River water rather than groundwater to irrigate with.

#### What are some ways you can help during a drought?

- Don't let water flow off lawns into the gutter.
- Use a nozzle on your hose when washing the car.
- Plant desert-friendly plants.
- Turn off water when you're not using it.
- Spread mulch over the soil so it holds more water.

• Water plants in the morning or evening, or when it's not sunny.

• Sweep rather than washing down driveways and patios.
